

WORDING YOUR BEQUEST

Following are some suggestions you may wish to consider for the wording of your bequest.

1. SPECIFIC REQUEST

We suggest that you seek professional advice in drawing up or modifying your Will so that your intentions are clear.

It is also important to communicate your wishes to your family.
